This booklet will help you find the right materials to help you study for your courses; the subjects teachers have put together lists of resources that you can use to help prepare for prelims and final exams. Many teachers will have issued you with revision materials already. In each of your subjects you should have enough materials to allow you to study, practice and prepare for your upcoming prelims and exams.

The departments have also listed where and when study support takes place. This is an excellent way to improve and you should use it where you can. If times clash, think about attending the subject that you need most help in. You could also go to subjects on alternate weeks.

In addition to this the Senior Prefect's have included some advice on how to prepare for your prelims and final exams. You are advised to make a revision timetable for over the holidays, a basic template is included.

Scholar is an excellent free online resources for students to use. Scholar has in-depth resources across a range of subjects and levels. Pupils should ask their subject teacher for the password if you don't already have it.

Exam Preparation

- Collect all books/jotters/folders into subject bundles and store in subject boxes.
- Go through one subject at a time and sort all notes/folders/jotters by topic.
- Always tidy up and file away different subject material immediately after use. This reduces the build up of clutter and means you won't lose focus.
- Get your resources organised e.g. pens, pencils, ruler, calculator or a dictionary.
- Divide time between your social life and your study time. Agree in advance when you will see your friends and don't pressurise one another to go out.
